I. Western Europe in Decline

- A. Rome collapsed after economic, political, military decline.
- B. From 500 to 1000 Western Europe was considered the "dark ages" due to lack of leadership and chaos.

II. Germanic Kingdoms

- A. Between 400-700, Germanic tribes, such as the Goths, Vandals, Saxons, and Franks, created small kingdoms.
 - B. In 732, the Franks stopped the Muslim's from advancing into Europe.

III. Charlemagne

- A. Charlemagne created a unified Christian empire
- B. Attempted to reunited much of the old western Roman empire

IV. Europe after Charlemagne

- A. Charlemagne was an example to later medieval rulers
- B. The new empire did not remain together
- C. Invaders, such as Vikings, settled in Europe
