I. Protestant Movement in England

- A. The Pope would not grant Henry VIII a divorce from his wife and marry another to gain a male heir
- B. Parliament passed the Act of Supremacy which named Henry VIII the head of the Anglican Church (church of England)
- C. Henry VIII married 6 wives and had three kids (Mary, Elizabeth, and Edward)
- D. Elizabeth I was England's first queen and her rule was considered a "golden age"

II. Catholic Counter Reformation

- A. The Catholic Church defended attacks against them
- B. The pope set up an inquisition to try and attack people who went against the Church
- C. Held the Council of Trent to create new rules for the church
